Please write the abstracts in English, whereas oral presentations and slides can be in English or in Italian (note that Italian is the official language of the workshop).
- The presentations shall be aimed at illustrating the research activities of the author, for instance through a specific study or by a wider overview;
- Each presentation will last 15 mins and will be followed by a brief space for questions;
